Wescott Medical Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2045.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

We initially set 2020 as our base year for emissions calculations. This year was chosen to align with our relocation to a new business premises and seemed, for this reason, to be a good starting point. However, we have now re-baselined. Our base year is now 2024. This was the first year we submitted a carbon footprint report, for this reason it is a more suitable base year. 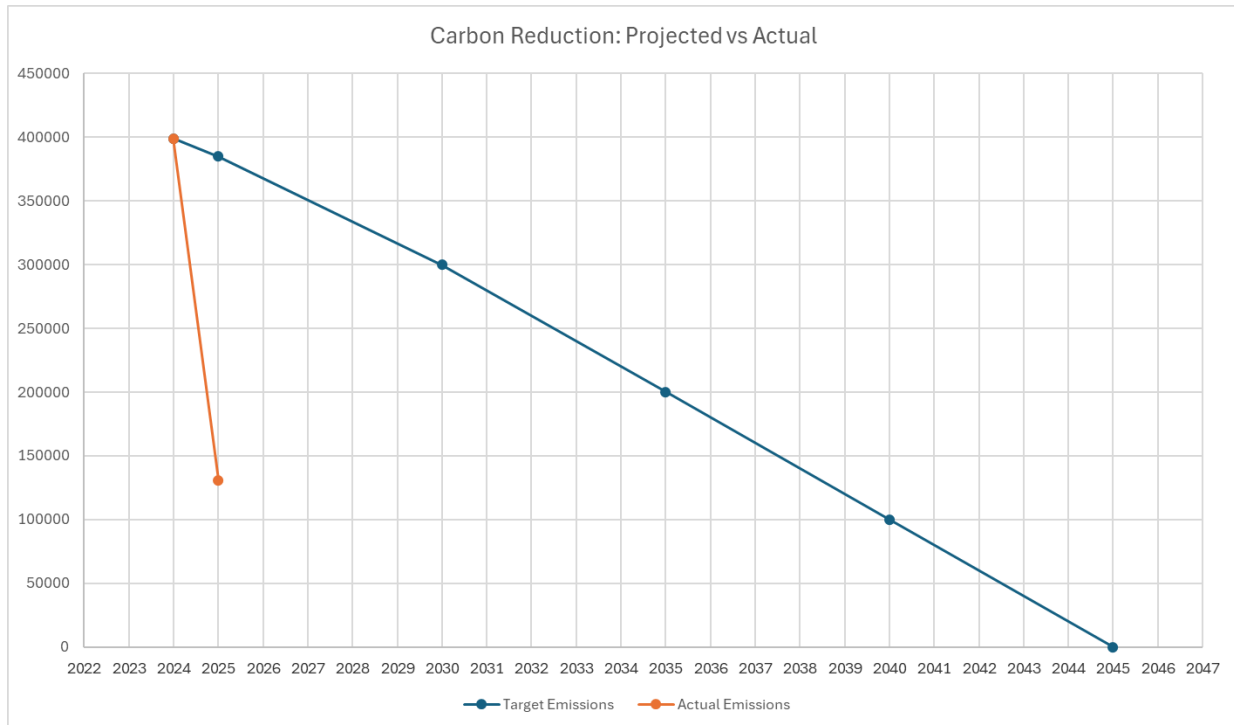

To continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 117 tCO₂e by 2030. This is a reduction of 10%

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the beginning of Wescott Medical carbon reduction journey (2020).

- Introduced new tender requirements for electricity and gas suppliers. Now purchasing 100% renewable electricity.
- Installation of efficient LED lights throughout the premises.
- Installation of double-glazing in admin offices.
- Admin offices now insulated to the most up-to-date standard.
- Installation of new domestic boiler with 93% efficient (A-rated)
- A commitment to now only heat warehouse locations where stock must be kept at a required temperature. This amounts to only 20% of our warehouse area meaning 80% is not being unnecessarily heated.
- All paper used in admin offices is FSC approved.
- Supporting staff health and wellbeing. Installation of comprehensively equipped communal kitchen to encourage healthier eating on site. Fruit and other healthy snacks also provided for staff.
- Introduction of cardboard box re-use scheme. This involves asking staff to bring in unwanted cardboard usable boxes that would usually be recycled at home. These boxes are now being used as outer cartons on some of our outgoing deliveries.

- Increased pack sizes on some of our products where possible. This means there is now less cardboard being used in packaging as a result, and therefore less waste.
- Reduced the number of diesel cars in the company fleet by a third.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Work with the NHS to be more efficient with orders and collections. With more careful planning, we believe less associated vehicle miles could be attributed to orders from our business.
- Identify further opportunities to reduce waste.
- Identify further opportunities to reduce energy usage.
- Install double-glazing in remaining admin offices.
- Educate ourselves and identify further opportunities to support staff health and wellbeing.
- Continue our move away from reliance on a fully diesel and petrol company fleet.
- Install on-site electric charging point for staff without company cars to support individual sustainability decisions.
- Explore the possibility of installing a heat pump to move away from using natural gas.
- Continue to monitor the solar panel market, assess potential opportunities generate own sustainable energy on site.

Declaration and Sign Off
